RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA MESA AWARDING THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF 20 AUTOMATED LICENSE PLATE READER CAMERAS TO FLOCK GROUP, INC.

WHEREAS, the La Mesa Police Department wishes to expand the technological capabilities to more effectively solve crimes through purchase and implementation of Automated License Plate Reader (ALPR) cameras;

WHEREAS, the City received a quote from Flock Group, Inc. for the purchase and installation of the ALPR camera systems, as well as the storage of data captured, for the amount of \$124,500 for a two-year period;

WHEREAS, the City's Purchasing Officer may waive competitive bidding when it is determined that, due to special circumstances, it is in the City's best interest to purchase a commodity without compliance with the bidding procedure, per La Mesa Municipal Code Section 2.40.070(a)(7); and

WHEREAS, by purchasing directly from Flock Group, Inc. instead of using a formal bid process, the City will enhance the effectiveness of the cameras due to the interoperability with neighboring law enforcement partners.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of La Mesa, California, that the City Council intends to award the purchase of 20 ALPR cameras to Flock Group, Inc. for \$124,500.
