SUBJECT: City of La Mesa 2022 Climate Action Plan Annual Report Presentation

In March 2018, City Council approved the Climate Action Plan (CAP), which charts a course to reduce community-wide greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions. Development of a CAP was identified as a mitigation measure in La Mesa's 2012 General Plan Update. La Mesa prepared the CAP and established targets consistent with State goals and guidance. The CAP provides a roadmap by which La Mesa can reduce its contributions of GHG emissions in energy, transportation, solid waste, water, and green infrastructure. The CAP requires Annual Reports and an update to City Council on CAP progress. A progress report to City Council occurs every six months.

The City of La Mesa's 2022 CAP Annual Report (Attachment A) contains a high-level overview of accomplishments since the City Council adopted the CAP. More details on each measure are outlined in the 2022 CAP Annual Report Appendix to document additional implementation details on a measure-by-measure basis to track progress (Attachment B).
