One appointee will fill the position vacated by Robert Duff whose term expires December 31, 2024, and represents the older adult population.

One appointee will fill the vacant Police Beat 3 seat with term expiring December 31, 2023.

Eleven of the members shall be residents of the City of La Mesa and be comprised as follows: One representative from each of the four police beat areas of the City; One representative of a La Mesa faith-based community; One representative of the La Mesa business community; One adult employee or designee of Helix Charter High School; One adult employee or designee of the La Mesa-Spring Valley School District; One young adult between the ages of 18 to 30; One advocate for people experiencing homelessness, substance abuse, mental health or other social issues; and One senior aged 62 or older
