Climate Action Plan Reduction Strategy:

 GI-1 Urban Forest Master Plan – Support natural carbon sequestration opportunities through continued development and maintenance of a healthy, vibrant urban forest.

BACKGROUND:

In November, 1979, the City Council adopted a policy for the removal, replacement and trimming of trees and landscaping within the public right-of-way including private vegetation that encroached into the right-of-way. In November, 1997, the City Council adopted an ordinance establishing a process to develop and maintain a Tree Policy Manual and designated the Development Advisory Board (DAB) as the City Tree Board (Municipal Code Section 24.02.037).

In March, 2021, the City Council amended Section 24.02.037 by dissolving the DAB and delegating to the Public Works Department the DAB function of City Tree Board.

DISCUSSION:

The current edition of the tree policy manual requires updating to reflect the change approved by the City Council in 2021 related to the delegation of the City Tree Board function to the Public Works Department. Staff will make the appropriate edits to the Manual and republish-it on the City's website.

CONCLUSION:

Staff recommends the City Council re-adopt the 2013 City of La Mesa tree policy manual and direct the Public Works Department to revise it to reflect the 2021 ordinance changes.
