City's Strategic Goals:

BACKGROUND:

San Diego Art Matters is a nonprofit organization that focuses on supporting local governments and art agencies expand the arts and serve as a local network for artists, nonprofits, art organizations and government entities. With funding from the Prebys Foundation, San Diego Art Matters will create a cohort of up to eight local city agencies for a year-long capacity building training, once a month, as part of the San Diego Local Arts Network. The grant will range from \$10,000 – 20,000.

DISCUSSION:

If accepted to participate in the Local Arts Agency Capacity Building program, the City of La Mesa would designate one staff member and one citizen volunteer to participate in the monthly, meetings through December 2025. The program goals are to exchange information and learn best practices in the local arts agency field with a particular focus in the areas of cultural advocacy, cultural planning, arts and the economy, arts and cultural policy, board development, cultural tourism, community outreach, arts education, program development, and arts marketing.

CONCLUSION:
