RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA MESA
AUTHORIZING A CHANGE TO THE APPROVED COMPENSATION PLAN TO
REFLECT A CLASSIFICATION WITH AND WITHOUT PARAMEDIC
CERTIFICATION INCENTIVE PAY FOR AN 80-HOUR AND 112-HOUR FIRE
BATTALION CHIEF

WHEREAS, the City of La Mesa Paramedic Program was developed in FY 2003.

WHEREAS, the terms and conditions of the Paramedic Program were negotiated between the City of La Mesa and the Heartland Firefighters of La Mesa, #4759 (hereinafter referred to as "Fire Association"); and

WHEREAS, a change is necessary to accurately compensate current and future employees in the Fire Battalion Chief classification based on their maintenance of a paramedic certification establishing eligibility for incentive pay.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of La Mesa, California that the City Council approves the change to the above-referenced compensation plan to include paramedic certification to the Fire Battalion Chief classification.
