RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA MESA AUTHORIZING TRANSFER AND APPROPRIATION OF UNALLOCATED FUND RESERVES TO THE PUBLIC WORKS STREET CLEANING ACCOUNT FOR STREET SWEEPING

WHEREAS, on June 12, 2018, the City Council awarded a street sweeping maintenance contract to Canon Pacific Services Inc., DBA Pacific Sweeping and the award includes the option to renew four, one-year extensions based upon satisfactory performance of work as determined by the City Engineer. Later, Canon Pacific Services, Inc. was purchased by Sweeping Corporation of America (SCA) in March 2021;

WHEREAS, \$182,680 was budgeted for street sweeping services in FY22-23 to cover the anticipated charges for street sweeping services for the budget year;

WHEREAS, in October of 2021, The State of California Department of Relations (DIR) determined that street sweeping maintenance services constitute public work and therefore were subject to prevailing wage requirements;

WHEREAS, SCA the sole provider of major street sweeping services in the region, has raised their service rates due to the DIR determination and increase of vehicle and operating expenses;

WHEREAS, in August of 2022, the Legislature failed to put into law a provision in the state code that street sweeping was subject to prevailing wage requirements; and

WHEREAS, the temporary change of contract rates due to the prevailing wage requirements from the State of California DIR created a deficit in our allocated budget for street sweeping.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of La Mesa, California, that the transfer and appropriation of funds from Unallocated General Fund Reserves be transferred to the Public Works Street Cleaning Account in the amount of \$80,000 to cover the cost of sweeping services through June 30, 2023.
