RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA MESA TO INCREASE THE BUDGET FOR THE LA MESA SUCCESSOR AGENCY AFFORDABLE HOUSING LAWSUIT PROFESSIONAL AND SPECIALIZED SERVICES ACCOUNT BY \$30,000 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023, FOR A TOTAL OF \$70,000 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR

WHEREAS, the City, as the Successor Agency of the La Mesa Community Redevelopment Agency, continues to defend against a lawsuit filed by the Affordable Housing Coalition of San Diego County related to affordable housing obligations of redevelopment agencies;

WHEREAS, the defense of the lawsuit has exceeded the amount of \$40,000 as approved the California Department of Finance through the Recognized Obligation Payment Schedule (ROPS) from Redevelopment Property Tax Trust Fund (RPTTF) monies for such defense;

WHEREAS, any additional expenses incurred in defense of the lawsuit must be paid from the City's General Fund;

WHEREAS, A request will be filed with the California Department of Finance to adjust the ROPS to reimburse the General Fund with RPTTF funds; and

WHEREAS, the La Mesa Successor Agency Professional and Specialized Services account (711-64300-671) needs to be increased by \$30,000 to maintain legal services anticipated for the remainder of Fiscal Year 2022-2023, for a total of \$70,000 for the Fiscal Year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of La Mesa, California, that:

\$30,000 is appropriated from General Fund Unappropriated Reserves to increase the budgeted amount for the La Mesa Successor Agency Affordable Housing Lawsuit Professional and Specialized Services account (711-64300-671) for Fiscal Year 2022-2023 to \$70,000.
